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Tour Itinerary

Day 01: Cairo (D)

Arrival in Cairo international airport, Meet & Assist at the airport and After going through Immigration, Baggage Claim and Customs, Transfer to the hotel Overnight.

Day 02: Cairo Full day Tour (B,L,D)

Breakfast at the hotel is followed by a full day tour. In the morning you will be driven to see the Pyramids of Giza and the Great Sphinx: the most famous monuments of not only ancient Egypt, but of the whole ancient world! These massive stone structures were built around 4,500 years ago on a rocky desert plateau close to the Nile.

In the afternoon you will be taken to the Egyptian Museum: gaze at the wonders of King Tutankhamen, including his golden death mask; stare upon the mummies of some of Egypt's ancient pharaohs (optional); lose yourself in the many rooms and galleries, where thousands of artefacts are awaiting your visit. At the end of this exciting day you will be driven back to your hotel.

Day 03: Cairo City tour + Nile Cruise Dinner (B,L,D)

After breakfast you will be taken to the Citadel of Saladin, the fortress built between 1176 and 1183 AD, to protect Cairo from the Crusaders and rebuilt by Muhammad Ali Pasha, whose mosque is a "must see". From here you will be taken on a tour of Cairo famous Churches, including: The Hanging Church and the Church of St. George the Martyr, 2 churches built into the walls of the Fort of Babylon and its remains could be Cairo's oldest structures; and the Church of Abu Serga (St. Sergius), where, it is said, the Holy Family took shelter in a cave, with the church being erected her to commemorate this. This whole area is a world famous destination for Pilgrims. Before being driven back to your hotel you will have the opportunity to visit the old market of Cairo (Khan El-Khalili)

In the evening there is **Nile cruise dinner**, which lasts for 2 hours, sailing on the Nile with Folkloric Shows and Belly Dancers. At the end of this cruise you will be driven back to your hotel.

Day 04 : Cairo - Istanbul

Early breakfast at the hotel .You will then be transferred to the Cairo Int'l airport for catch Istanbul Flight. On arrival in Istanbul, take a transfer to the hotel.

Day 05: Princess Islands Tour

The Princess Islands are a combination of nine islands off the Asian coast of Istanbul, in the <u>Sea of</u> <u>Marmara</u>. Regular or fast passenger ferries operate to the four of these islands from different parts of the city; from Bostanci, <u>Kadikoy</u> and Kartal neighborhoods on the Asian side, from Sirkeci and Kabatas neighborhoods on the European side. Motorists are not permitted on the islands except the ones belonging to the local municipality for public works, therefore you have to walk or rent a bicycle or horse-drawn carriage (fayton in<u>Turkish</u>), even a donkey. Many local people in Istanbul own or rent their

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summer houses, or just go there at the weekends for swimming in the tiny beaches and for picnicking.

These four islands are called in general as Adalar (Islands) in Turkish and their names are; Büyükada, Heybeliada, Burgazada, and Kinaliada. Sedefada is the fifth inhabited island but it isn't much popular as the other ones, there is a very small settlement on it. Beside these, Tavsan Adasi, Sivriada and Yassiada have no settlements on them, meanwhile Kasik Adasi is a private island. Yassiada witnessed a tragic moment in our recent history when one of our early Republic period <u>prime ministers</u>, <u>Adnan Menderes</u>, was sentenced to death penalty after spending his last days of life in a prison on this island.

The name of the islands comes from the <u>Byzantine</u> period, when royal princes and empresses were exiled there. With the introduction of steamboats during the late <u>Ottoman</u> period around the 19th century, these islands became popular resorts for the rich people who built their wooden houses. Jewish, Greek and Armenian communities were a large part of the inhabitants here. Today, the islands are popular tourist destinations for daily excursions especially in the summer time. There are many monasteries and historic buildings on the islands, besides 19th century Victorian style old wooden mansions. **Day 05: Half day Istanbul City Tour**

After noon Free time for shopping.

Day 06: Bosphorus Cruise

In the afternoon set out on a cruise along the Bosphorus, the winding strait separating Europe & Asia. Along the shores enjoy a delightful mixture of the past and the present, as well as the grand splendor and quaint beauty of the ancient wooden villas, palaces of marble, fortresses and small fishing villages and later visit the Spice Market.
