Tour Itinerary

DAY 1 : AIRPORT - KANDY

Meet and assist on arrival at Airport by our Representative
Transfer from Airport to Kandy . On the way you may enjoy natural beauty of Kandy.
Overnight Stay in Kandy.

DAY 2 : KANDY (CITY TOUR) - TEA PLANTATION - NUWARA ELIYA

After breakfast visit around Kandy city.

The World Heritage Site, Kandy, was the last capital of the Sri Lankan Kings, before the country was brought under British rule in 1815. Famous for its rich heritage and splendor, this magnificent city was last ruled by Sri Wickramarajasinghe. The Temple of the Tooth Relic is the most significant highlight of the city along with the Kandy lake, the town and other attractions. Visit the Kandy Town and Bazaar, the arts & crafts centre and a gem museum and a lapidary. In the evening, visit the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic and thereafter, witness a cultural show featuring traditional Sri Lankan dance. Transfer from Kandy to Tea Plantation

Visit a tea plantation and a tea factory, where the best tea in the world is produced. Upon your visit you will observe how the quality of tea is graded and also have a walk-through of the manufacturing process. The highlight of your visit will be enjoying the taste of a cup of pure Ceylon tea in the factory. Transfer from Tea Plantation to Nuwara Eliya . **Overnight Stay in Nuwara eliya.**

DAY 3 : NUWARA ELIYA (CITY TOUR) - KITULGALA - GALLE (CITY TOUR)

After breakfast visit around Nuwara Eliya city.

Nuwara Eliya has earned a reputation for itself as a preferred destination in the hill country by tourists and locals alike because of its incredibly cool climate and amazing sceneries. Whilst delighting travellers with its awe-inspiring beauty, Nuwara Eliya is also home to one of the finest 18-hole golf courses in South Asia. This town plays a pivotal role in the world's tea industry as the produce of this region alone accounts for a substantial portion of tea exports.

Thereafter proceed to Galle via Kitulgala

The Kelani River provides adventure seekers a treat with shooting rapids that facilitate white water rafting. The river's clear water is born in the heart of the peak wilderness reserve and tumbles through a rocky gorge just above Kithulgala. As you progress on the thrilling journey, you will pass the scenic location of the river where the movie 'The Bridge on the River Kwai' was filmed.

Galle is located in the south-western part of Sri Lanka and is an important city in the region. The city remains the best example of a fortified city built by the Portuguese during their period in the country. The Galle Fort, today, is a world heritage site and the most important landmark in the city. The Dutch Museum and the Dutch Church are two other significant attractions. Galle has also made a name for itself for its intricate lace and ebony carvings.

Overnight Stay at the beach hotel.

DAY 4 : GALLE - BALAPITIYA BOAT RIDE - KOSGODA TURTLE HATCHERY

After breakfast proceed to Balapitiya

Balapitiya is the nearest town to the Maduganga River which is famous for its mangroves and endemic flora and fauna. This little town is renowned for its Ceylon Cinnamon and fishing.

Thereafter proceed to Colombo en-route visit Kosgoda

Kosgoda is a small village located in the west coast of Sri Lanka. It is most popular for its sea turtle hatcheries, operated by the Wildlife Protection Society of Sri Lanka. Here you will feast your eyes upon the amazing site of many species of turtles, especially the endangered hawksbill, laying their eggs along the beaches. The many hatcheries that are operated locally provide a safe haven for these sea turtles. You may visit these hatcheries to have a look at many huge tanks filled with new born turtles who, once grown, are released to the sea. Afternoon Transfer to Colombo. **Overnight Stay in Colombo**

DAY 5 :After breakfast proceed to city tour of Colombo, like many capital cities in developing countries is fast changing its face. Almost overnight, skyscrapers arise from where old buildings once stood. Yet in some parts, the old world charm is retained. For example, there is a 100-year-old clock tower and several British built colonial buildings. Other places of interest are the Pettah bazaar - where one can shop for bargain, a Hindu and a Buddhist temple, residential areas where you find the stately homes of the affluent, the Colombo museum, the Bandaranaike Memorial International Conference Hall (BMICH)- an outright gift to Sri Lanka from the People's Republic of China and the Dutch Museum.
